Infants—Looking back at last week

This week we have begun to explore the story of Jack and the Beanstalk, thinking about whether it is a traditional or fairy story, which describing words we liked in a written version and even listening to a meditation in which we imagined climbing the beanstalk and what we might see at the top! We have continued our work on multiplication, introducing the 'X' sign and describing our calculations using arrays. Reception have been singing rhyming action songs and designed a 'be kind to the environment' poster. Reception have also done some super acting out of the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'

Infants—Looking forward to next week

Next week we will be thinking of our own versions of Jack and the Beanstalk and reading a version called Jim and the Beanstalk. We will be growing our own beanstalks (or maybe not, as some will have no water, some will have no light and some no soil!). Reception will be looking at 'Dance of the Dinosaurs'. We will be exploring and experimenting with sounds, words and text and will be focusing on rhyme and action words. We will be using our imagination to go to their own special land. In maths we will be counting to 20 and then counting back from 10. There will be lots more rhyming action songs to keep us all busy!

Juniors - Looking back at last week

This week in the Juniors the children have written some great portal stories with fabulous descriptions of the Stone Age. We have really enjoyed reading them and have been helping each other to edit and improve our writing. In Science we have been learning how fossils are formed – thank you very much for those children who brought in fossils for us to look at. In Maths Y3 and 4 have been working on division and Y5 and 6 have been looking at area and perimeter. The children have started some creating leaflets about the Stone Age settlement Skara Brae, which are looking great and full of interesting information.

Juniors—Looking forward to next week

Next week, we will be carrying out group research tasks to find out about Stone Age animals. The children will then choose their own animal to write a report about which will give the reader lots of useful information. In Topic we will be finishing our leaflets and finding out more about Stone Age homes, as well as creating some of our own. We will continue with our work on fossils in Science finding out about the famous palaeontologist Mary Anning and investigating fossils to decide what they were!

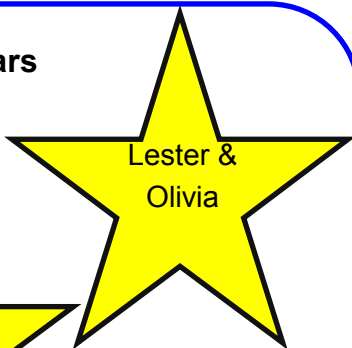
