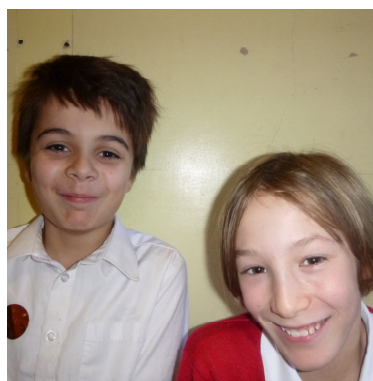
# Sports Fixtures and Results
