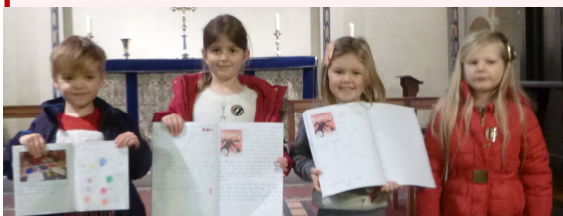
### Juniors - Looking back at last week
