### Infants—Looking back at last week

This week Reception have been looking at a variety of books in literacy. They have designed a new book character, named them and described how they looked. They have also made a gingerbread man to eat. Y1 & Y2 have been heroic in their maths this week—adding and subtracting using equipment, pictures and big calculations! They have watched an animation about poppies and have found out about how and why people remember on Remembrance Sunday. The children have been cast in their parts for the nativity play—those with speaking parts will be bringing home their scripts!

### Infants—Looking forward to next week

Next week Reception will be measuring objects using tape measures and learning about centimeters. They will be throwing bean bags and measuring how far they have travelled. KS1 will be producing beautiful writing based on a CBBC animation. In PHSE we will be looking at what makes a good relationship and how to have and be a good friend. The children will also be having their first nativity rehearsal—please check book bags as scripts are being sent out to those children with speaking parts and start helping your child to learn their words! Thank you.

### Juniors - Looking back at last week

In Literacy this week we have started some work to develop our understanding of the Holocaust. We have examined pictures from World War 2, as well as playing a trading game where certain traders and customers were discriminated against. We were very proud of how well the children presented in the Remembrance Service in church - they show great empathy and appreciation of the sacrifices made during WW1 and 2, as well as in other Wars. In Science we have started our new topic of light with the Y3 and 4 children trying to guess what objects were without light to help, and the Y5 and 6 children creating their own educational programmes.

### Juniors—Looking forward to next week

Next week we will be developing our knowledge of evacuation and we will be making labels for our own evacuation! We will also examine the contents of an evacuee's suitcase and be thinking about what we would need in our suitcases. We will be reading the book, 'Star of Fear, Star of Hope' which is a picture book that sensitively approaches the subject of the Holocaust. In Maths we will be continuing to practice times tables and mental Maths skills. Remember to keep having a go on Times Tables Rock Stars or Hit the Button. In Science the Y5 and 6 children will need a cereal box within the next couple of weeks – we would greatly appreciate some being sent into school.
