Juniors

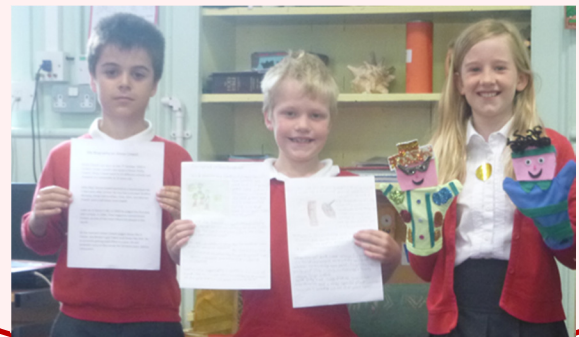
Looking back at last week
