## **South Darley C.E. Primary School Statement of Principles of Behaviour**

- We are a caring community, whose values are built on Christian values of mutual trust and respect for all.
- Every member of the school community will be valued and respected and will be treated fairly and well.
- Every member of the school community should feel happy, safe and secure.
- Every member of the school community will behave in a considerate way towards others.
- School rules will be agreed by children and staff, and will be applied in a consistent way.
- School rules will be used as a means of promoting good relationships so that people can work together with the common purpose of helping everyone to learn.
- When school rules are broken reasonable sanctions will be used.
- The health and safety of all is of the utmost importance. We expect no child to behave in a way that will endanger others or damage school property.
- We believe staff should use reasonable force to control or restrain a child only if the health and safety of that child, or another, is threatened, or school property would be damaged, by failure to do so.
